- INDIO
- A <u>member</u> of any of the <u>indigenous</u> peoples of America or eastern <u>Asia</u> in areas <u>formerly subject to Spain</u> or <u>Portugal</u>.
- mid 19th century: from Spanish and Portuguese, literally 'Indian'.
- INDIAN
- Relating to <u>India</u> or to the <u>subcontinent</u> <u>comprising India</u>, <u>Pakistan</u>, and <u>Bangladesh</u>.
- Relating to the <u>indigenous</u> peoples of America
- The native <u>peoples</u> of America came to be <u>described</u> as **Indian** as a <u>result</u> of Christopher Columbus and other <u>voyagers</u> in the 15th-16th <u>centuries</u> <u>believing</u> that, when they <u>reached</u> the <u>east</u> coast of America, they had <u>reached</u> part of <u>India</u> by a new <u>route</u>. The terms <u>Indian</u> and <u>Red Indian</u> are <u>today</u> regarded as <u>old-fashioned</u> and <u>inappropriate</u>, <u>recalling</u>, as they do, the <u>stereotypical portraits</u> of the <u>Wild West</u>. <u>American Indian</u>, however, is <u>well established</u>, although the <u>preference</u> where <u>possible</u> is to make <u>reference</u> to <u>specific peoples</u>, <u>such as Apache</u>, <u>Delaware</u>, and so on. See also <u>American Indian</u> (<u>usage</u>) and <u>Native American</u>.
- INDIGENOUS
- Originating or occurring naturally in a particular place; native: the indigenous peoples of Siberia coriander is indigenous to southern Europe.
- mid 17th century: from <u>Latin</u> indigena 'a native'








